South has a 3 loser hand. With 22 points a 2 vopening is better than 1 v. After North's negative/waiting response South shows his club suit and North is just strong enough to show his hearts – just 3 points but the 6th heart justifies it. South now closes the auction by bidding 3NT.

With 23 points, South starts with a conventional 2 and rebids his suit over the negative/waiting 2 response. North's 3 shows some values, since he would bid the second negative of 2NT with 0-3 points. South rebids his hearts and North proceeds to game. With a singleton in his partner's suit South doesn't bid any further.

North opens 24 and rebids 2NT to show 23-24 balanced. This sequence isn't forcing, so with only 1 point South just passes.

South opens a strong 2♣ and North makes a positive 2♠ bid. South shows his balanced hand by rebidding 2NT (although a raise to 3 would also be acceptable). When North rebids his spades South uses Blackwood and bids the grand slam when North shows two aces. Even with both hands being short in hearts, the chances of making are close to 80%.

When North shows 23-24 points balanced by rebidding 2NT, South just raises to 3NT.

North bids 2♣ followed by 2NT to show 23-24 points balanced. South uses Stayman, but settles for 3NT when North denies 4 hearts by bidding 3.

South bids 24 followed by 2NT to show 23-24 points. North uses Stayman and raises to game when South shows 4 hearts.

South has 8 points but the heart suit is not good enough for a 2♥ response so South bids a waiting $2 \spadesuit$. North now shows his spades. South's $3 \spadesuit$ shows a reasonable hand – with a weaker hand South would have bid $4 \spadesuit$ (Principle of Fast Arrival). North now bids Blackwood and settles for 6NT when South has only one ace.

North has three hearts so could bid 4♥ but with a flat hand with good cover in all suits and no ruffing potential he rebids 3NT offering a choice of games, 3NT or 4♥. South passes.

North opens a strong 2 and shows his long diamond suit over South's negative/waiting 2 response. South can now bid spades to show a reasonable hand and 5+ spades, but passes when North converts to 3NT.

North shows his second suit and South gives preference to spades. This does not promise 3 card support. North suggests 3NT as an alternative contract and South is happy to pass.

North has just 20 points but has only 4 losers and a long major (hearts) so opens 2 de and rebids 2 de after South's negative/waiting bid. South's 2NT rebid is a 'second negative' showing 0-3 points and saying "partner I am not going to bid again". North decides to sign off in 3.
