Recap on Overcalls and SQOT

Suit Quality Overcall Test (SQOT)

•SQOT = number of cards in the suit + number of honours in the suit ("10" counts as an honour)



$$SQOT = 7 (5 + 2)$$

$$SQOT = 7(6 + 1)$$

$$SQOT = 9(5 + 4)$$

Requirements for making an overcall

•8+ HCP for a 1 level overcall

•10+ HCP for a 2 level overcall

·Good 'quality' in the overcall suit

Overcalls AR

These hands are (just) worth a 2-Level suit overcall:

★ A J **♥** 9 **♦** 10 4 **♣** K Q 8 7 6 3 10 HCP; SQOT = 8

AJ ♥9 **Q** 4 **E** K 9 8 7 6 3 2 10 HCP; SQOT = 8

Do you open the bidding with this hand?



Hopeless in Defence




Playing in $2 \spadesuit$ we can make 5 tricks on our own

We would definitely overcall with this hand, but by then the opponents are 'talking'

We need to get our retaliation in first - we need to pre-empt our opponents

Making a Pre-emptive Bid



Bid 2 A!







You are North and open a Weak 2♠

West

- ◆ K Q 8 6 2

East -West can make 4 but will they bid it?

Weak 2 Opening bids

- 2 \Rightarrow 6-10 HCP & 6 diamonds (SQOT= 8)
- 2 → ⇒ 6-10 HCP & 6 hearts (SQOT= 8)
- $2 \Rightarrow 6-10$ points & 6 spades (SQOT= 8)

You will rarely bid again ... you have JUST one shot

You must announce your bid: say "Weak"

NOTE THAT 2* is <u>NOT</u> used to show this type of hand The 2* opener is a SPECIAL bid showing a STRONG hand

Your side have 10 hearts. Bid to the level of the fit.

Your opponents have at least 25 HCP and will make 4♠ if you let them find their fit. Obstruct!

Bid 3 **Y**!

Bid to the level of your fit.

Your opponents may well be able

to make 3 \(\Delta \). Obstruct!!

Partner opens 2 and you have this hand

Bid 3NT!

★ K 6 2

♥ K 9 3

♦ A K 6

♣ A 9 4 3

You have entries to establish partner's hearts. At least five heart tricks
You have a good stop in every suit.

Partner opens 2 and you have this hand

Bid 4 !!

Bid to MAKE. You have a fit and 17 points including shortage.

- ♣ A K 4 3 2

Partner opens 2 and you have this hand

Don't rescue!!

You are too weak to bid 3♣ A new suit shows interest in a game contract. Partner must bid again!!

Choices: 3 ♥; 4 ♣

- ♣ KQ8542

Partner opens 2 and you have this hand

Bid 2 A

Partner must bid again.

Choices: 3 ♥; 3 ♠; (weak)

4 ♥; **4** ♠








West now has to guess what to do. Have you 3 points or 12 points???







Weak 3 Opening bids

- \bullet 3 \Rightarrow 6-10 HCP & 7 clubs (SQOT= 9)
- $\bullet 3 \bullet \Rightarrow 6-10 \text{ HCP & 7 diamonds (SQOT= 9)}$
- $\bullet 3 \lor \Rightarrow 6-10 HCP \& 7 hearts (SQOT= 9)$
- $\bullet 3 \Rightarrow 6-10 \text{ HCP & 7 spades (SQOT= 9)}$

Once you have pre-empted do not bid again! Partner is now in charge!

These bids are DESTRUCTIVE ... we want to make it hard for the opposition

Partner opens 3 vand you have this hand

Bid 4 *!

Your side have ten hearts. Bid to the level of the fit. **♠** 7

v 8 7 4

◆ Q 8 7 6 2

♣ K 9 4 3

Your opponents have at least 25 HCP and will make 4♠ if you let them find their fit. Obstruct, Spoil, Bu***r them up!

- •PASS \Rightarrow 0-15 points, 0-2 card support
- •4 level Raise \Rightarrow 0-15 points, 3+ card support "Bid to the level of your fit"
- GAME \Rightarrow 17+ points, any shape

Partner opens 3 vand you have this hand

Bid 4 *!

You have a heart fit and 18 points including shortage Bid to make.

- **♠** 7
- **♥** Q 4
- ◆ A K 7 6 2
- ♣ A J 4 3

NEW OPENING BIDS ... 4-level

- $4 \lor \Rightarrow 6 10$ points with a GOOD 8-card heart suit
- $4 \implies 6 10$ points with a GOOD **8-**card spade suit

A GOOD suit is a suit with 2+ honours in the suit

These bids are DESTRUCTIVE ... we want to make it hard for the opposition

WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN THE OPPOSITION MAKES THESE WEAK BIDS?

- The same rules apply for X's
- The same rules apply for overcalls
- The same rules apply for bidding NT's

JUST be mindful that you might need slightly better point counts

Vulnerability

If you miss your contract by 2 tricks and are doubled the penalty is:

Not vulnerable: -300

good if opps can make game - 400-420 not vulnerable;
 600-620 vulnerable)

Vulnerable: -500

- good if opps are vulnerable and can make game (600+)
- bad if opps are not vulnerable and can make game (400-420)

Vulnerability

If vulnerable - be cautious - bid to one less than the level of your fit. With 10 combined cards in opener's suit, bid to make 9 tricks.

If not vulnerable and the opponents are vulnerablebe aggressive if you think they are likely to make game.

Try to avoid preempting partner

• When partner has not had a chance to bid and you have a good 4 card major as well as your long suit -your bid may pre-empt partner if he was planning to open in the major.
